Western Star Test Drive Procedures with Salesperson (for a short distance within Missouri but without a load)¹

1. Make copy of customer's driver's license and medical card and ensure that they are current and make sure that of proper class (CDL required for anything 26,001 GVW and above). If not already familiar with the customer, obtain background information (address, business, phone numbers, etc.) and make certain the description of the individual on the license matches the person with whom you are dealing.
2. Make copy of customer's insurance card and ensure that it has not expired.
3. Salesperson should accompany all test drives.
4. Annual Inspection Slip (sample attached) must be in glove box (even though a new truck).
5. Need fire extinguisher and three triangles.
6. Use Midway Sterling's DOT number (available from Shari Fulks).

Western Star Test Drive Procedures without Salesperson (without a load)¹

1. Make copy of customer's driver's license and medical card and ensure that they are current and make sure that of proper class (CDL required for anything 26,001 GVW and above). If not already familiar with the customer, obtain background information (address, business, phone numbers, etc.) and make certain the description of the individual on the license matches the person with whom you are dealing.
2. Make copy of customer's insurance card and ensure that it has not expired.
3. Short form Demonstrator Agreement (Form 1) fully completed and signed.
4. Annual Inspection Slip (sample attached) must be in glove box (even though a new truck).
5. Customer's DOT number should be displayed on truck
6. Fuel permits if required (sample attached) —note informal advice from both Kansas and Illinois is that each state will honor Missouri demo agreement on a heavy truck provided a proper fuel (trip) permit is obtained. Iowa will not. Numbers to obtain fuel permits: Kansas (785) 271-3145; Illinois (800)373-9033.
7. Need fire extinguisher and three triangles (we either must provide or ensure customer does).

NOTE: Any person driving the test vehicle provided by Allison Transmission (with or without a load) must also sign the Driver Conduct Requirements (Form 3). The Allison test vehicle must NOT be operated "for hire".

¹ An empty trailer used just to test maneuverability is not considered to be a load. Thus, demonstrator forms 1 or 1A may be used to pull an empty trailer.

Western Star Demonstrator Agreement Requirements
(with load)

1. Make copy of customer's driver's license and medical card and ensure that they are current and make sure that of proper class (CDL required for anything 26,001 GVW and above). If not already familiar with the customer, obtain background information (address, business, phone numbers, etc.) and make certain the description of the individual on the license matches the person with whom you are dealing.
2. Make copy of customer's insurance card and ensure that it has not expired.
3. Full Demonstrator Agreement (Form 2) complete and both pages signed.
4. Annual Inspection Slip (sample attached) must be in glove box (even though a new truck).
5. Customer's DOT number should be displayed on truck
6. Fuel permits if required (sample attached) —note informal advice from both Kansas and Illinois is that each state will honor Missouri demo agreement on a heavy truck provided a proper fuel (trip) permit is obtained. Iowa will not. Numbers to obtain fuel permits: Kansas (785) 271-3145; Illinois (800)373-9033.
7. Need fire extinguisher and three triangles (we either must provide or ensure customer does).
8. Need to receive a certificate of insurance from Customer's insurance company evidencing required coverages (See demo agreement and sample certificate).
9. Sales Manager (not salesman) needs to sign demo agreement.

NOTE: Any person driving the test vehicle provided by Allison Transmission (with or without a load) must also sign the Driver Conduct Requirements (Form 3). The Allison test vehicle must NOT be operated "for hire".

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DEMONSTRATION AGREEMENT (LOADED)
Form 2 – Loaded, Single or Multiple Drivers (10/1/10)

Terms and Conditions of Demonstrator Agreement

1. Vehicle is Midway's property. This Agreement is a license agreement under which Customer may demonstrate the Vehicle. Customer is not Midway's agent for any purpose. Any service to or replacement of a part or accessory to Vehicle during the Demonstrator period must have Midway's prior approval. Customer acquires no rights other than the right to use Vehicle in accordance with this Agreement.

2. During its period of use, Customer shall ensure that the Vehicle is operated in accordance with all applicable laws and regulations including, without limitation, that: (a) the operator is qualified and duly licensed, with all required certifications and endorsements, to operate the Vehicle; (b) Customer's DOT number is properly displayed if required on the class of vehicle being demonstrated; (c) any required fuel permits are timely obtained; and (d) driver logs are properly maintained. Customer shall return Vehicle to Midway in the same condition as received, except for ordinary wear, to Midway. Midway reserves the right to repossess Vehicle at any time without demand at Customer's expense if Vehicle is illegally parked, used for an illegal purpose, is apparently abandoned, has not been returned by the due date, or is being used in violation of this Agreement. Customer waives prior notice, pre-seizure hearing and judicial process as prior condition to Midway's repossession and Midway may enter upon Customer's premises without being liable for trespass for repossession purposes.

3. LIABILITY PROTECTION PROVIDED BY CUSTOMER: Customer shall at its sole cost and expense, provide liability coverage for Customer and Midway, and their respective agents, servants and employees, in accordance with the standard provisions of a basic automobile liability insurance policy as required in the jurisdiction in which Vehicle is operated, against liability for bodily injury, including death, and property damage arising out of ownership, maintenance, use or operation of Vehicle with a combined single limit of \$1,000,000 per occurrence. Such coverage shall be PRIMARY and not excess or contributory and shall be in conformity with the basic requirements of the applicable motor vehicle insurance laws. Customer agrees to provide a certificate of insurance, prior to taking possession of the Vehicle, with Midway listed as additional named insured. Each insurer shall agree, by endorsement upon its policy that it shall give Midway thirty (30) days prior written notice of the effective date of any alteration, modification, or cancellation of such policy and that such notice shall be sent to Midway at Midway's address stated on this Demonstrator Agreement. CUSTOMER SHALL DEFEND, INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS, MIDWAY AND ITS AGENTS AND EMPLOYEES, FROM AND AGAINST ALL LOSS, LIABILITY, AND EXPENSE AS A RESULT OF BODILY INJURY, DEATH OR PROPERTY DAMAGE CAUSED BY OR ARISING OUT OF OWNERSHIP, MAINTENANCE, USE OR OPERATION OF THE VEHICLE.

4. DAMAGE PROTECTION PROVIDED BY CUSTOMER: Customer agrees to be solely responsible for all loss or damage to the Vehicle during the Demonstrator period.

5. Customer agrees to report any accident, loss of, or damage to, the Vehicle to the Midway immediately and in writing, within 24 hours after such accident, loss or damage, and must immediately deliver to Midway copies of every process, pleading or paper of any kind relating to any claim, demand, suit or proceeding received by Customer or the driver. Customer and driver shall comply with all requirements of applicable insurance policies carried on the Vehicle including, without limitation, any which require them to refrain from aiding or abetting in the assertion of any claim and shall cooperate with Midway and the insurer in the investigation and defense of any claim or suit

6. Vehicle shall NOT be used: (a) to carry persons for hire or to push any other vehicle; (b) to carry persons other than drivers or helpers employed by Customer who shall ride only within the cab (provided the carrying of passengers in the cab does not violate any laws or regulation concerning the carriage of passengers); (c) to tow any other vehicle except a trailer without passengers, and only then if vehicle is equipped with a compatible coupling device permitting the safe and lawful towing; (d) for the carrying or hauling of Explosives or Other Dangerous Articles defined by the US Department of Transportation; (e) for the transportation of any intoxicating liquors or other contraband; (f) while Customer or Authorized Operator is under the influence of intoxicants, hallucinatory drugs, or narcotics; or (g) for any race, test or contest. IF VEHICLE IS USED IN ANY MANNER, OR FOR ANY OF THE PURPOSES, PROHIBITED BY THE PROVISIONS OF THIS PARAGRAPH OR IN VIOLATION OF APPLICABLE LAWS AND REGULATIONS, OR IS USED FOR AN ILLEGAL PURPOSE, ALL USE IS WITHOUT MIDWAY'S PERMISSION.

7. Customer shall: (a) return Vehicle with the same amount of fuel as rented; (b) obtain and pay for all tolls or special fees or taxes required by any law or regulation, including, but not limited to, trip permits or licenses; (c) pay all towing expenses, if Vehicle becomes stuck in mud or snow and (d) where required by law, or by Midway, complete and submit to Midway, immediately upon return of Vehicle to Midway, or sooner if required by Midway, Driver Trip Records and legible fuel receipts (originals if requested by Midway).

8. CUSTOMER HEREBY INDEMNIFIES AND HOLDS MIDWAY AND ITS OFFICERS, EMPLOYEES, AGENTS AND ASSIGNS AND, EACH OF THEM, HARMLESS FROM AND AGAINST ANY AND ALL CLAIMS, DEMANDS, SUITS, LOSSES, DAMAGES, INJURIES, FINES, EXPENSES AND OTHER LIABILITIES OF ANY KIND OR NATURE WHATSOEVER WHICH MAY BE ASSERTED AGAINST THEM, OR ANY OF THEM, ARISING OUT OF, OR RELATED TO: CUSTOMER'S NEGLIGENCE IN THE OPERATION OF THE VEHICLE; CUSTOMER'S BREACH OF ANY DUTY OR OTHER OBLIGATION UNDER THIS DEMONSTRATOR AGREEMENT; CUSTOMER'S POSSESSION OR USE OF THE VEHICLE; AND ANY INJURIES OR DAMAGES OCCURRING AS A RESULT OF ANY WRECK OR ACCIDENT INVOLVING THE VEHICLE WHILE UNDER CUSTOMER'S CARE, POSSESSION OR CONTROL; INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, ANY COSTS, EXPENSES AND ATTORNEYS' FEES WHICH MAY REASONABLY BE INCURRED BY CUSTOMER INCIDENT TO ANY SUCH CLAIMS OR DEMANDS.

9. MIDWAY SHALL IN NO EVENT BE LIABLE FOR ANY INDIRECT, SPECIAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES IN CONNECTION WITH, OR ARISING OUT OF, THE USE, OPERATION MAINTENANCE, OR PERFORMANCE OF VEHICLE, INCLUDING ANY CLAIM RELATED TO A VEHICLE RESERVATION.

10. Where Vehicle is operated by Customer with a trailer or other equipment not covered by this Agreement, Customer warrants that such trailer or other equipment will be in good operating condition, compatible in all respects with Vehicle, and in full compliance with all laws and regulations covering said trailer or other equipment and Customer shall indemnify Midway, its agents and employees, from and against all loss, liability, and expense resulting from Customer's failure to comply with the foregoing.

11. Customer shall pay all parking, traffic, and operating violation fines and penalties and agrees to defend, indemnify and hold Midway harmless in the event Midway pays such fines and penalties on behalf of Customer and to reimburse Midway for all its collection and other expenses relating to same. Customer authorizes Midway, in connection with claimed violations of law, to release to the governmental agency having jurisdiction thereof any information relating to Customer which Midway has in its possession.

12. Customer has no right to, and agrees not to assign, transfer or sublet this Agreement.

13. The provisions contained in this Agreement apply equally to all substituted Vehicles.

14. No term or condition of this agreement may be waived or modified as to Midway except by a written instrument signed by Midway's authorized representative.

15. This Demonstrator Agreement is executed and entered into in the State of Missouri and shall be governed in all respects by the laws of the State of Missouri (without regard to any so-called "borrowing provisions"). The parties agree that any action relating to this contract, or arising out of the transaction(s) contemplated hereby shall be brought solely in the federal or state courts within the State of Missouri and not in the courts of any other state or jurisdiction. Each party hereby waives the right to a jury trial and waives the right to request a change of venue.

9. Require any person to whom the assigned driver gives permission to operate the assigned Vehicle to be in compliance with these Driver Conduct Requirements contained herein, including verifying that the person possesses a valid driver's license or operator's license.
10. Have read, understand and will comply with all terms and conditions contained in the LOAN OF VEHICLE AGREEMENT AND DRIVER CONDUCT REQUIREMENTS.

Furthermore, by signing this receipt and acknowledgement, I verify that I have not been convicted with in the past 36 months of any of the following vehicle violations:

1. Driving while driver's license or operator's license is suspended, revoked or denied.
